

## Guidelines for crediting ECTS for Dissemination Activities, PhD Programme Studies of Bildung and Pedagogical Practices

The programme committee may approve other activities as part of the training component with up to 5 ECTS. This includes activities such as popular science research dissemination, presentations at scientific conferences, or longer stays at other research institutions.

The following guidelines for awarding credits apply:

- Research stay of 3 months or longer 3 ECTS
- Research stay of 2 months 2 ECTS
- Shorter research stay of minimum 2 weeks 1 ECTS
- Overall assessment of other dissemination activities (conferences, presentations, editorials, popular science publications, shorter Erasmus stays, etc.) up to 2 ECTS
- Participation in research school seminars, 25-30 hours of school activity is equivalent to 1 ECTS

A research stay is defined as a stay at another research environment different from the one the candidate belongs to and can also apply to stays at another institution in Norway.

The programme committee approves the credit-earning activities and the number of ECTS assigned to each activity. Applications for approval are processed by the programme committee after the completion of the activities. Similar to the requirements for courses, training elements should also be no older than two years at the time of application for admission. Applications must include attachments documenting the activities and are processed after the overall completion of the activities for which credit is requested.



## Guidelines for Crediting Dissemination Activities

1 ECTS corresponds to a standard work time of 25 to 30 hours (including active participation and self-study).

Popular science written article/editorial/interview within the candidate's field, Wikipedia article (min. 1000 words), or scientific article not forming the basis for admission or included in the thesis.	1 ECTS per article/editorial, max 2 ECTS	An interview must cover a topic within the candidate's research field.  Documentation:  The article/editorial.  For a Wikipedia article, documentation of how the article appeared at the time of publication, including the date.
