

Practical information about the venue and the presentation

Dear everyone,

Below is some practical information about the venue and presentation time.


Most of you are probably staying at the City Box Hotel, at Danmarks plass. It is located 1 km from the venue (see map below) and the distance is walkable.

The 13SSS venue is at light rail stop: Kronstad and the City Box Hotel is at the light rail stop: Danmarks plass.

A single ticket costs 40 kr (around 4 euros). A 7 days ticket costs 235 kr (around 23,5 euros). It is suggested to by the 7 days ticket if you prefer not to walk.



The venue: The Western Norway University (HVL) is located next to the light rail stop Kronstad. The parallel sessions take place in the white large building (K2 building), and the plenary sessions take place in the main steel colored building (K1), in the main auditorium 'Mimes Brønn'. The 'Global lounge' is directly next to the main entrance in building K1. The entrances for both buildings are located opposite each other. See maps below.



Format for the presentations at the parallel sessions

For the parallel sessions, each presentation is max 15 minutes and 5 minutes for questions and discussions. Maximum 20 minutes per long paper presentation! Please respect the other speakers to NOT extend your speaking time!

Bring your presentation on a USB stick. Make sure that your .ppt file is installed on the in-room PC at latest 15 minutes before the session starts. There are several people who are attending 13sss online due to Covid19, visa problems, and health problems. Therefore, we have decided that the discussion and question part is short after each paper. Many thanks for your help for keeping to the time schedule. Due to the online streaming, it is not possible to make the presentation with your own pc.

We have one extra room on the 4th floor at the K2 building for pure online presentations. It is possible to sit there and listen to the online attendances. Please bring with you ear plugs for attending our online attendances if you want to sit around in the campus. The online participants will be happy to see you. There you can interact with great presenters all over the world. Internet code and password will be provided when you arrive at the 13sss.

The poster session:

In the hall between all the parallel session rooms on floor 2 in the K2 Building, we have 22 great posters that will be exposed. For those of you who have a short paper/poster please bring with you your poster in an A1 format. It is suggested not to print it here in Bergen due to the high prices and the slow service. During the poster sessions on Wednesday afternoon, all authors of the poster will stand in front of their poster for questions and discussions. What is new is that we also have a table for all the 'nutty nerdy' space syntax questions. Please bring your laptop and enjoy the discussions.
