## UTSTYR

### Clothes/necessary gear

### Klær/nødvendig utstyr

- long underwear, preferably woollen
  - thick socks woollen
  - thin socks woollen
  - shirt or thin sweater woollen

  - anorak, wind jacket with hood
  - winter jacket and pant if you have

  - raincoat (water min 10000mm)
  - rain trousers
  - knitted hat/warm cap without tassel
  - mittens (gloves)
  - wind mittens / extra mittens
  - mountain boots
  - wellingtons
  - sunglasses
  - sun protecting oil/cream (high factor)
  - thermos
  - sturdy knife, sharpening tool(chopping wood)
  - toiletries
  - warm sleeping bag (minus10)
  - mountain mattress/sleeping pad
  - swimmingwear
  - head torch
  - cutlery and plastic cup and teller
  - rucksack (60 litre or more)
  - insect repellent
  - map case and compass

  - \* vindtett jakke med hette

- leggings/gaiters
  - books: flora, plant and animals in sea/seashore, mushrooms

Some former students have asked us to underline that it might be a good idea to buy some of the equipment in Norway. They found that quality goods were cheaper and easier to find on Stord than in The Netherlands/Denmark/Germany/England. This is especially the case with woollen clothes, rain gear, wellingtons, mountain boots and to lesser degree rucksacks and wind jacket / trousers. You do not have to bring stove and tent the school will provide this during your stay.
